### DAPHNE RUBIN-VEGA

Two-time Tony nominee Daphne Rubin-Vega first lit up on Broadway as Mimi in the original cast of *Rent*. ### PHOEBE SNOW

Phoebe is one of the most distinctive voices in popular music. In 1972 she produced her first recording, spawning the Top 5 hit single, "Poetry Man," winning Snow a Grammy Award nomination for Best New Artist and established her as a formidable singer/songwriter. Platinum records, the cover of Rolling Stone magazine, and legions of fans followed.



### LARITA GASKINS

LaRita is a member of the world renowned Broadway Inspirational Voices. She has appeared on *Saturday Night Live*, *A&E*, *The David Letterman show*; and recorded albums and performed live shows for such greats as *Aretha Franklin*, *Patti Label*, *Vanessa Williams*, *Brian Stokes*, *Debbie Gibson*, and *Wilson Pickett*.



### NITA WHITAKER

A former Miss Louisiana, Nita Whitaker's show-stopping singing talent is extraordinary. Just ask Andrea Bocelli with whom she tours, singing duets to tens of thousands around the world.
